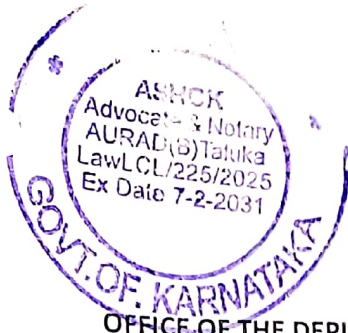

Conditions:

1. The school has been registered under the Child Rights Education Act 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the rules made thereunder, and the recognition has been renewed up to the class for which it was registered. No additional classes and additional sections are allowed to be conducted outside these classes.
2. The school shall function under the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the rules made thereunder.

3. Child Rights Education Act 2009, under the rules made thereunder, 25% seats will be reserved for children from weaker sections. The government will have the power to enroll the seats reserved by the government for schools falling under the purview of RTE under RTE. [The government has made rules to facilitate enrollment in schools near the residence of the parents of the children, and accordingly, if there are government or government-aided educational institutions, the children will be enrolled in that school] In case there are none, private schools will be allowed to enroll the children enrolled by the government and continue their education up to the primary level. These children will be allowed to continue their studies without any discrimination.

4. The Government shall release the fees of the children enrolled under the RTE Act as per the rules as explained in Section 3. Therefore, it is prohibited to collect any fee from these children.

5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any kind of capitation fee and voluntary donations from the parents either at the time of registration or later.

6. The school / management shall publish the information about the fees collected from the parents of the children as tuition fees in their school on the departmental website and on the school notice board as per the State Government Notification No.: ED:31:PGC:2019, Date:27.07.2019. No additional fee shall be collected over and above the prescribed fee.

7. The school / management shall enroll the students within the period fixed by the Government.

8. The school/management cannot deny admission against the following factors.

(i) Lack of proof of age,

(ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language

(iii) If admission is sought after an extended period of admission,

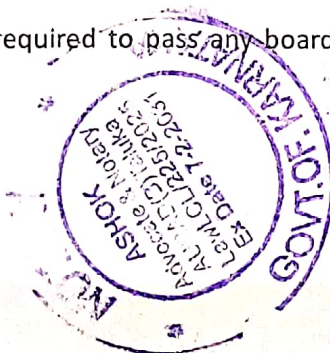
9. All safety measures as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules shall be taken. [Fire safety and building safety certificate from the concerned authorities and safety of children's learning as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R].

10. The school/management shall ensure that

(i) No child admitted to the school shall be kept in any class or expelled from the school till the completion of primary and secondary education.

(ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental harassment.

(iii) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till the completion of primary education.



(iv) Every child who completes primary education will be issued a certificate as prescribed under Rule 21 of the RTE and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

(v) The school shall also accommodate children with special needs/special needs as per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

(vi) The teachers appointed shall possess the minimum educational qualifications as prescribed for primary and secondary school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.

(vii) The salary and allowances and terms and conditions of service payable to the teachers shall be as prescribed by the State Government. And the salary to be paid to the teachers shall be as per Government Notification [Provident Fund (PF)] and payable by the bank and other emoluments. And shall be covered by the Employee State Insurance (ESI).

(viii) The teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section 24[1] of the Act and Rule 17 of the RTE Act and Rules and Rule 17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory purposes.

11. The school shall follow the academic state curriculum and state text books to which it is affiliated.

12. The school shall maintain the rules and norms as specified in Section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act. The departmental staff shall be appointed as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

13. The school buildings and other infrastructure facilities associated with the school shall not be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-academic activities, day or night.

14. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any individual or group or association.

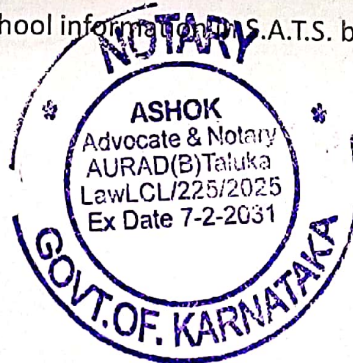
15. The school shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant. A copy shall be submitted to the Deputy Director/Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.

16. The school shall follow the language policy as per the government notification [Kannada Language Policy 2016].

17. The management board and teachers shall act as per the RTE Act and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

18. The school/management board shall strictly follow the rules and directions of the government and the department.

19. It is mandatory to upload the school information on S.A.T.S. by the end of March of every year as per the rules.



20. In case of violation of the above conditions, the school's recognition will be cancelled as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.

21. After the school recognition process is completed, the entire documents/information in the application submitted online by the Governing Body will be made publicly available on the departmental website.

22. In case of violation of the above conditions, the school's recognition will be cancelled as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
